



User Guide

The KURO-BOX/PRO is a small-footprint Linux-based embedded platform for a personal server. You can boot and run the embedded Linux on the 256 NAND FLASH. If you install a HDD in the KURO-BOX/PRO, you can boot, run and customize the OS from the HDD.

Installing a HDD



Before beginning the installation, disconnect the AC power cord from the wall outlet. If not avoided, this may result in electric shock.




Remove a screw from the bottom of the KURO-BOX/PRO.




Lift up the front panel to remove it from the chassis.




Remove 2 screws and the cable indicated.




Slide out the mainboard.



Plug the connector into the mainboard, then into the



Secure the SATA-HDD with the included 2 screws.



Install the mainboard and the SATA-HDD into the KURO-BOX/PRO. Secure the mainboard with the 2 screws removed in step 3, then connect the cable indicated.



Insert the front panel, then secure it with the screw removed in step 1.

Hardware Diagrams



①Power LED

Green. The POWER LED lights up when the KURO-BOX/PRO is powered on. The LED flashes when the KURO-BOX/PRO starts a shutdown process.

2 Power Button

Use the power button to start or shut down the KURO-BOX/PRO.

Hold the Power Button down for 3 seconds to shut down the KURO-BOX/PRO.

Hold the Power Button down for 9 seconds to force to shut down the KURO-BOX/PRO.

3LINK/ACT LED

Green.The LED lights up when the KURO-BOX/PRO is connected to a device. If the LED is flashing green, the KURO-BOX/PRO is sending or receiving data over that port.

4INFO LED

Orenge. The LED flashes when there are any

system messages. **⑤ERROR LED**

Red. The LED is flashing when the system is not



6AC Power Connector

The connector is where you will connect the included AC power cable.

7FAN

Cooling FAN

®INIT Button

If you are experiencing extreme problems with the KURO-BOX/PRO and have tried all other troubleshooting measures, press and hold in the INIT button for 5 seconds. This will restore the factory defaults and clear all of the settings.

9Wire Hall

Works with anti-theft hall.

10LAN Port

The port connects to network device.

11) USB 2.0 Port

The port connects to USB device.

12 Earth Ground

You can connect to earth cable.

Make sure to observe the instructions of the computer and peripheral manufacturers when installing and using the KURO-BOX/PRO.



Do not attempt to disassemble or repair the KURO-BOX/PRO. This may result in fire or electric shock



Only insert the plug into a 100-220V (50/60Hz) AC socket. Using the device with a different voltage may result in a short circuit, smoke or fire.



Insert the AC adapter firmly into the AC Socket.



Using the equipment without the AC Adapter firmly inserted may cause a short circuit or overheating, or result in fire or electric shock.



Do not damage, process, overheat, or attempt to repair the power supply cable. This may result in fire or electric shock.

- When installing the equipment, do not crimp the power supply cable between walls and racks (shelves) etc. · Do not place heavy objects on the power supply cable, or pull at the cable.
- · Do not place the power supply cable close to heat sources, or overheat the cable in any way.
- When removing the power supply cable, be sure to remove it my holding the plug.
- Do not bend the cable past its natural bending radius.
- Do not move the KURO-BOX/PRO while the power supply cable is still connected.



Install the equipment in a location where children cannot reach the interior of the electrical equipment, cables, or connectors. Failure to do so may result in injury.





Continuing to use the device under these conditions may result in a short circuit, fire, or electric shock. Consult with your dealer immediately.



Do not use the LinkTheater in bathrooms or other locations with a lot of water or humidity. Using the device under these conditions may result in fire or electric shock.



If the product is dropped or subjected to a severe shock, remove the AC adapter immediately. Continuing to use the device under these conditions may result in a short circuit, fire, or electric shock.

6 Remove

If liquid or foreign matter enters the equipment, remove the plug from the power socket. Continuing to use the device under these conditions may result in a short circuit, fire, or electric shock. Consult with your dealer immediately.



Only use the power cable and AC adapter provided with the LinkTheater. The polarity and voltage of the terminal may differ between makes. Which may result in smoke and fire.



Strongly

To Prevent damage due to static electricity, before touching the equipment, first touch a nearby metal object (such as a door handle or metal window blinds) to discharge any static electricity from your body.


- · Locations with strong magnetic fields (may result in damage).
